School Council is **highly recommending** to parents to purchase a laptop through the LWT portal OR purchase with finance a laptop through the LWT portal.

These two options provides students and parents with:

- Ongoing technical support at home and school for 3 Years from the LWT and SEPS technicians
- 3 Years Onsite Warranty
- 3 Years Insurance
- Immediate access to Edustar software

Laptops from the LWT portal will be sent to SEPS and will then be imaged by our technician.

Laptops can be purchased at any time from now, over the Dec / Jan holidays and all throughout 2020. Please note that the <u>sooner</u> you purchase the earlier your child will be able to use it to support their learning. We have found over the past few years that most students have their 1-1 laptop within the first month of the school year.



School Council also offers a BYOD option where students are able to bring a device from home. However BYOD devices must meet the strict school specifications listed below to be connected to the SEPS Wifi network. Conditions of this option are:

- 1. SEPS notified by parents that a BYOD will be brought to school
- 2. Minimum technical requirements met and verified by SEPS technician see below
- 3. Waiver signed stating Parents take responsibility for all upkeep and damages
- 4. The device will be connected to the SEPS Wifi by the SESP technician
- 5. Students / Parents to download Edustar software during out of school hours at school
- 6. **No technical support** at school by the SEPS technician or teachers

BYOD Minimum Requirements:

- Laptop or Tablet with non-Bluetooth keyboard (not Chromebook or MacBook or MacProduct)
- Windows 10
- Memory min 4GB
- WiFi 802.11n capable
- At least 1 available USB port
- Screen size 11" min
- Weight less than 2KG
- Bag

Currently SEPS has an agreement with the parent community regarding second hand devices from the 2015 - 2019 1-1 Computer programs being brought to school and imaged by a SEPS technician. This agreement will continue until the device is 4 years old.
