The annual walk-a-thon is an important fundraiser, empowering the students to help raise money for their school through sponsorship, while having the benefit of exercise and fun as they walk with their friends and teachers.



All sponsorship money needs to be collected and returned to school by Friday 23rd March. The 10 students who raise the most will receive awesome prizes, including:



Incentive prize winners announced at assembly on Monday 26th March.

*The Family prize goes to the siblings who have raised the most money all together.

Questions & Answers



How do I get sponsors?

Ask your family to be sponsors. That is easy since they know you. If you ask neighbours, be sure a parent comes along with you. Asking neighbours who know you usually works out best. **NEVER** enter a home if you are going door to door. Also, go during daylight hours. If you go to a particular shop or business, they may like to sponsor you. Your parents or relatives can also find more sponsors for you at their workplace.

Your sponsors can either give you a one-off fixed amount donation, or they may sponsor you a particular amount for each lap that you walk around the course. If they sponsor you by the amount of laps you do, you will need to collect money from them after the actual walk (e.g. They pledged \$1.00 per lap. You walked 15 laps. They owe you \$15.00).

What should students wear?

House colours (eg. shorts/leggings and a Tshirt in your house colours and by all means go all out with house coloured hair, socks, hair ties etc) runners, sunscreen, a school hat and a big smile! Please also bring a labelled bottle of water.

What happens on the day?

Students will each be given a Lap Card that will be stamped every time they complete a lap of their walk. At the end of their walking time, the lap cards are returned to the teacher with their sponsorship forms for processing. Both are returned to the students by the end of the day so the sponsorship money can be collected.

How many laps is it likely my student will walk?

In Foundation, students will complete many laps. On average, you can expect them to walk anywhere from 16 to 24 laps! The older students can be expected to walk fewer laps based on the increased distance.

When does the sponsorship money have to be returned?

If you have collected all fixed amount donations and have received the funds, hand the money in on the day of Walk-a-thon. Otherwise, please return your money as soon as possible after the event, but no later than Friday 23rd March. Payment may be made by cash or Qkr.

How do we win an incentive prize?

Incentive prizes will be awarded to the top 10 fundraising students, who have returned their money by 23rd March. Families who have paid the Busy Parents Contribution will have \$70 allocated to each child.

How can I help?

Volunteers will be required throughout the day with marshalling the walkers, stamping the lap cards, serving icy poles after students finish and processing the lap cards/sponsorship forms. Please have a look at the online roster and signup if you are able to help www.volunteersignup.org/4M9A9, or just come along and walk a lap or two with the students, or cheer from the sidelines.

How will the Walkathon funds be spent?

Funds will be allocated to furnishings required for the new school buildings including: blinds air conditioners, outdoor learning environment furniture, soft furniture for classrooms eg ottomans, beanbags, extra cabinetry, landscaping, extra resources for Art, Performing Art, PE. and Japanese




Add your children's details in Student Profiles

Step 3 Find our school


Our school will appear in 'Nearby Locations' if you're within 10km's of the school, or search for our school by name.
